### Stampin' Up! Supplies:

- STAMPS - Nature's Beauty (151528)
- PAPER - Thick Very Vanilla Cardstock (144237), Very Vanilla Cardstock (101650), Toile Tidings Designer Series Paper (150432)
- INK - Garden Green Ink Pad (147089), Early Espresso Ink Pad (147114)
- OTHER - Stitched Rectangle Dies (148551), Toile Tidings Glitter Enamel Dots (150433), Multipurpose Liquid Glue (110755), or Snail Adhesive (104332), Stampin' Dimensionals (104430)

### Cutting & Scoring:

- Thick Very Vanilla - 8-1/2" x 5-1/2" card base, score & fold at 4-1/4"
- Very Vanilla - 3-1/4" x 4-5/8"
- Toile Tidings Designer Series Paper - 3-1/2" x 4-3/4" for die-cutting a stitched rectangle frame

### Instructions:

- Use Garden Green ink to stamp trees on the right and left sides of the front of the Thick Very Vanilla Card Base.
- Use Early Espresso ink to stamp the deer and the shrubs onto the Very Vanilla panel.
- Use the Stitched Rectangle Dies to cut a frame from the panel of Toile Tidings Designer Series Paper.
- Attach the frame cut out to the front of the deer panel.
- Secure three Garden Green Toile Tidings Glitter Enamel Dots in graduated sizes on the bottom left side of the frame as an accent.
- Attach the completed deer panel to the front of the card base with Stampin' Dimensionals.
